BOND PROJECT WINTER UPDATE

MS/HS Building Renovations & Additions

- The Phase 1 building addition including the new weight room, art, band, and choir spaces was opened in late-fall of '22 and currently in use!
- Construction of the Phase 2 multi-purpose gym and locker rooms continues with a schedule completion and turnover in the summer of 2023. This will include a new entry to the facility along with completion of the new parking lot, bus loop and surrounding landscaping.
- The bond team has begun planning and initial design discussions for Series 3 projects which include infrastructure upgrades at the MS/HS, security enhancements at the Elementary School and MS/HS, and new bleachers at the football stadium.

At Whiteford, we have students, teams, clubs, and groups doing some great things! I am excited to highlight our K-8 STEM program and Robotics Team in the latest Bobcat Tales! The K-8 STEM program is in its 5th year of existence, and is currently taught by Mrs. Mindy Welch. The K-8 STEM program is fortunate to have a brand-new space this year due in part to the community supported Bond Project. The students have thoroughly enjoyed the new space, especially the Lego Wall. With a colorful and open learning environment, our students' creativity is sparked through the many projects they complete. One project involved keeping an egg safe as it traveled in a student designed car down a ramp. For this project, the students learned about Newton's Laws of Motion. The STEM room is always full of curiosity, learning, and tons of fun! We are excited to see this program grow in this new space!

Whiteford Bobcats Team 6570 is in their 7th year of competitions and are led by Mr. David Welling and Mr. Jeremy Gapp. The 2023 team includes 23 student members that hold a variety of positions such as building, programming, communications, pit crew, drive team, spokesperson and safety, and strategy and scouting. The season game season is split up into three sections: Autonomous Mode, Tele-op Mode, and Charge Station. This year, the team is excited about the engineering challenge of working with two different game pieces: inflated cubes and rigid cones. They are hard at work designing an intake system and a delivery system. The team will be participating in two tournaments: Jackson, MI (March 2-4) and Lansing, MI (March 9-11).
