

SUPERINTENDENT FAMILY BULLETIN MAY 29, 2023

GREETING

Hey, Bobcat Families! Whether you are traveling or staying home this weekend, I hope you are having a wonderful Memorial Day holiday. I wanted to take a moment to share my gratitude to our families and community. Over the past year, we have experienced bus driver shortages that have led to the cancelation of bus routes on a rotating basis from October through December and more recently, we have been canceling routes when substitutes are unavailable. We try to give families as much notice as possible, but sometimes we are alerted to shortages at the last minute. Thank you for your ongoing flexibility and patience as we deal with the shortage. Additionally, this past week, we had an early release to allow us to host the TCC Track & Field Championships, which we host once every six years. We are grateful for our community's willingness to adjust to this change of schedule. Our families and community are so supportive of the school district, and we are so grateful for your ongoing support, especially as we navigate some challenges.

Lastly, let's talk a bit about our spring sports programs. In the TCC Track & Field Championships, our men's track team finished 2nd, missing 1st by just 1.5 points. Our women's team finished 3rd. Both our track teams ended up winning the TCC League Titles with their sweeps of the regular season meets. On Saturday (5/27), our track teams participated in the MITCA State Track & Field Championships in Clare, MI. Our men's team finished 6th out of 16 teams, and our women's team was 11th out of 14 teams. We competed very well against some of the biggest division 3 schools in the state. We have a few track and field team members competing next Saturday (6/3) at the MHSAA Track & Field Championships. Our baseball team was a co-champion in the TCC, and they host baseball districts on June 3rd. In softball, our girls had a perfect 12-0 record in the TCC to claim another league title. The girls will begin districts this week with a pre-district game on May 30 vs Blissfield. The District Semi-Final and Final will be held on Saturday (6/3) at Whiteford.
