<a href="#"><u>See, Think, Wonder</u></a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Something I saw...</li> <li>● Something I thought about what I saw...</li> <li>● Something that you wonder...</li> </ul>
<a href="#"><u>Claim, Support, Question</u></a>	<p>Make a claim about the topic, identify support for your claim and ask a question related to your claim.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Claim: An explanation or interpretation of some aspect of the topic.</li> <li>● Support: Things you see, feel, and know that support your claim.</li> <li>● Question: What's left hanging? What isn't explained? What new reasons does your claim raise?</li> </ul>
<a href="#"><u>I Used to Think... Now I Think...</u></a>	<p>Write a reflection using each of the following three sentence stems:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● I Used to Think...</li> <li>● Now I Think...</li> <li>● I need to further explore...</li> </ul>
<a href="#"><u>Circle of Viewpoints</u></a>	<p>Share a response to the following prompts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● I am thinking of ... [the topic]... From the point of view of ... [the viewpoint you've chosen]</li> <li>● I think ... [describe the topic from your viewpoint. Be an actor - take on the character of your viewpoint]</li> <li>● A question I have from this viewpoint is ... [ask a question from this viewpoint]</li> </ul>
<a href="#"><u>Connect, Extend, Challenge</u></a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Where do you see connections between the learned content and your current practice?</li> <li>● What from the learned content extends your thinking regarding ... ?</li> <li>● What challenges might you experience or anticipate as you work to integrate.... within your practice?</li> </ul>
<a href="#"><u>Compass Points</u></a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What Excites you?</li> <li>● What Worries you?</li> <li>● What do you still Need to know?</li> <li>● What Suggestions do you have?</li> </ul>
<a href="#"><u>Think, Puzzle, Explore</u></a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● THINK: What do you know now?</li> <li>● PUZZLE: What questions were generated? What needs to be clarified?</li> <li>● EXPLORE : What might you further explore?</li> </ul>
<a href="#"><u>What Makes You Say That?</u></a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What's going on?</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What do you see that makes you say that?</li> <li>• What else could it be?</li> </ul>
<b><u>Step Inside</u></b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. What can the person or thing perceive?</li> <li>2. What might the person or thing know about or believe?</li> <li>3. What might the person or thing care about?</li> </ol>
<b><u>Think, Feel, Care</u></b>	<p>Choose a variety of people within a system and then step inside each person's point of view. As you think about what you know about the system, consider what each person might think, feel, and care about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Think: How does this person understand this system and their role within it?</li> <li>• Feel: What is this person's emotional response to the system and to their position within it?</li> <li>• Care: What are this person's values, priorities, or motivations with regard to the system? What is important to this person?</li> </ul>
<b><u>Parts, People, Interactions</u></b>	<p>Identify a system and ask:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What are the parts of the system?</li> <li>• Who are the people connected to the system?</li> <li>• How do the people in the system interact with each other and with the parts of the system?</li> <li>• How does a change in one element of the system affect the various parts and people connected to the system?</li> </ul>
<b><u>The 3 Y's</u></b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Why might this [topic, question] matter to me?</li> <li>2. Why might it matter to people around me [family, friends, city, nation]?</li> <li>3. Why might it matter to the world?</li> </ol>
<b><u>Word-Phrase-Sentence</u></b>	<p>Review a text and then select:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A "Word" that captured my attention or struck me as powerful is...</li> <li>• A "Phrase" that moved, engaged, or provoked me is...</li> <li>• A "Sentence" that was meaningful to me, that I felt captures the core idea of the text is...</li> </ul>
<b><u>How Else and Why?</u></b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. What I want to say is... [Makes a statement and explains intention]</li> <li>2. Another way to say this is... [=Reframe statement based on intention, audience and situation]</li> <li>3. What I mean to say is... [Reframe statement based on intention, audience and situation]</li> </ol>
<b><u>Headlines</u></b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If you were to write a headline for this topic or issue right now that captured the most important aspect that should be remembered, what would that headline be?</li> <li>2. How has your headline changed based on this lesson? How does it differ from what you previously thought or heard?</li> </ol>

<u><b>Circles of Action</b></u>	<p>What can I do to contribute...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● In my inner circle (of friends, family, the people I know)?</li> <li>● In my community (my school, my neighborhood)?</li> <li>● In the world (beyond my immediate environment)</li> </ul>
<u><b>I Used to Think... Now I Think...</b></u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● I used to think...</li> <li>● Now, I think...</li> </ul>
<u><b>Colors, Shapes, Lines</b></u>	<p>Look at the artwork or object for a moment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What colors do you see?</li> <li>● What shapes do you see?</li> <li>● What lines do you see?</li> </ul>
<u><b>3-2-1 Bridge</b></u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 3 Thoughts / Ideas</li> <li>● 2 Questions</li> <li>● 1 Metaphor / Simile</li> <li>● Bridge: Explain how your new responses connect to your initial response?</li> </ul>
<b>3-2-1</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 3 things you found out</li> <li>2. 2 interesting things</li> <li>3. 1 question you still have</li> </ol> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Write 3 questions about the text (unfamiliar words, confusing passages or ideas)</li> <li>● Write 2 predictions based on the text (what will happen next based on the reading)</li> <li>● Make one connection based on the text (connect to something you know or have experienced)</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 3 key words</li> <li>● 2 new ideas</li> <li>● 1 thought to think about</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 3 important facts</li> <li>● 2 interesting ideas</li> <li>● 1 insight about yourself as a learner</li> </ul>
<b>One Sentence Summary</b>	<p>Select (or invent) one word which best summarizes a topic.</p>
<b>Four Roads</b>	<p>Based on this lesson, which road are you currently traveling? What makes you say that?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Dirt: There's so much dust, I can't see where I'm going! Help!!</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Paved: It's fairly smooth, but there are many potholes along the way.</li> <li>● Highway: I feel fairly confident but have an occasional need to slow down.</li> <li>● Interstate: I'm traveling along and could easily give directions to someone else.</li> </ul>
<b>RSQC2</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Recall and list in rank order the most important ideas</li> <li>2. Summarize those points in a single sentence</li> <li>3. Write one major question you want answered</li> <li>4. Identify a thread or theme to connect this material to the course's/unit goal.</li> </ol>
<b>Shape Reflection</b>	<p>Square Something that "Squares" with your thinking.  Circle: Something that is "Circling" in your head.  Triangle: 3 Points I want to remember</p> <p> Some things I noticed that square with my understanding..</p> <p> Some things that are circling in my mind are...</p> <p> 3 points I want to remember or think more about are...</p>
<b>One Question and One Comment</b>	Based on today's lesson, what is one question and one comment?
<b>Gots / Wants</b>	What did you get from today's lesson? What do you want further discussion/support?
<b>MIP (Most Important Point)</b>	<p>Reflect on what was learned or accomplished and complete one of the following prompts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The Most Important Point is...</li> <li>● Some things I found important...</li> <li>● Some key ideas were...</li> <li>● A summary might be...</li> </ul>
<b>Traffic Light</b>	<p>Select a stoplight color and complete the sentence:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Red: I am going to stop doing...</li> <li>● Yellow: I will continue doing...</li> <li>● Green: I am going to start doing...</li> </ul>
<b>Street Sign</b>	Which street road sign best reflects your current thinking or experience with this lesson? Why?

<b>Annotation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> key concepts/ideas "lifted line"</li> <li> I want to remember "lifted line"</li> <li> want to know more about "lifted line"</li> </ul>
<b>WOW (Walking Out With)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Some things I am walking out with are...</li> <li>● Some questions I am walking out with are...</li> </ul>
<b>Summary Context</b>	Craft a 3-5 sentence summary of today's learning and why it matters beyond success in school.
<b>Bumper stick Reflection</b>	Think of a key idea from your learning. Create a short 'bumper sticker' to represent thinking about the topic.
<b>All "A's"</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What Assumptions does the author of the text hold?</li> <li>● What do you Agree with in the text?</li> <li>● What do you want to Argue with in the text?</li> <li>● What parts of the text do you want to Aspire?</li> </ul>
<b>3 "A's"</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● One thing with which you agree</li> <li>● One thing with which you might argue</li> <li>● One thing to which you might aspire</li> </ul>
<b>Say Something</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● A key concept was...</li> <li>● Something I want to remember is...</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Something I want to know more about is...</li> <li>● I'm connecting with your thinking...</li> <li>● To add on to your thinking...</li> </ul>

<b>Pinwheel Reflection</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What are the connections between .... and ... ?</li> <li>● What keys ideas within .... need to be explored further?</li> <li>● How does .... drive ... ?</li> <li>● What are the main .... of ... ?</li> </ul>
<b>Create a Recipe</b>	<p>Create a recipe for a topic that mimics what you would see in a recipe for cooking or baking. For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 1 cup of ...</li> <li>● 1 teaspoon of...</li> <li>● 1 pinch of...</li> </ul> <p>Mix together and add a dash of humor...</p>
<b>Here's What ~ So What ~ Now What</b>	<p>Based on the learning in this lesson complete the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● "Here's what" ( was important?)</li> <li>● "So what" (why it matters)</li> <li>● "Now what" (will you do with the information/learning).</li> </ul>
