

Elementary Cell Phone/Device Policy

- All cell phones, smart watches or other communication devices are allowed to be brought to school.
- BUT, while at school these devices need to be powered off and stored out of sight.
- From the Whiteford Elementary Handbook pg. 23
 - "Students may possess wireless communication devices (WCDs) in school, on school property, during after school activities (e.g. extracurricular activities) and at school-related functions, provided that during school hours the WCDs are powered completely off (i.e., not just placed into vibrate or silent mode) and stored out of sight."
 - "Violations of this policy may result in disciplinary action and/or confiscation of the WCD."


