STRATEGIC PLAN BOND PLANNING

On Wednesday (12/13/23), stakeholders had their first opportunity to hear an update from October's Strategic Planning Stakeholder Meetings, share feedback and interest regarding the scope and costs associated with a possible elementary and athletic bond project, and understand next steps as we consider solutions to stabilize enrollment, lower class sizes, and address athletic complex needs. Stakeholders learned that the bond project would be a ZERO millage bond extension that could raise \$10 million dollars. There would be no tax rate increase as the current 4.93 millage would remain 4.93 for an additional six (6) years with the extension. If you were unable to attend the 12/13/23 meeting, it is recommended that you attend the 1/10/24 meeting at 6:30pm in rooms 2/3 of the middle/high school building. 23-24 SCHOOL CALENDAR AMENDMENT

At the November (11/30) Special Board of Education Meeting, the 2023-2024 School Calendar was amended to reflect the addition of an Early Release on Monday, December 18, 2023. On Monday (12/18), the Whiteford staff will be trained on our new SmartBoot Security System. At the April 17, 2023 Board of Education Meeting, the BOE approved the purchase of the LockOut USA Security System. The installation process is nearly complete. Our first step in the system becoming active is to train staff and students. Staff will be trained on 12/18 in the afternoon after students are released, and students will be trained in January 2024. For 12/18, the elementary will dismiss at 10:55am, and the MS/HS will dismiss at 11:05am. Bus transportation for our students will still be provided home. 
SCHOOL DELAYS / CLOSINGS
