

Chromebook Charging and Battery Safety



1. When charging a Chromebook use the correct power cord. Make sure it is the certified charger for your Chromebook.
2. When charging, plug into a grounded wall socket and do not run cords under rugs.
3. Keep Chromebook away from potentially flammable material like carpeting, rugs, and bedding. Leave room for ventilation under your Chromebook. Using your Chromebook on a hard surface, such as a desk or table, is best for proper air flow and allows the Chromebook to stay at a proper temperature. Using your Chromebook on a bed or blanket can decrease the airflow and lead to damaging high temperatures.
4. Check your charger to make sure there are no loose, frayed, or exposed wires or cracks.
** Do not use chargers with frayed ends or exposed wires.** Report them immediately.
5. If charger or Chromebook gets extremely hot while charging, please let an adult know and report it to the helpdesk.
6. Don't overload electrical outlets and avoid using extension cords when charging.
7. Handle battery-powered devices cautiously to not damage the battery casing or connections.
8. Keep batteries from contacting liquids.
9. Keep your Chromebook out of extremely high or low temperature locations. Do not place the battery in direct sunshine, or store the battery inside cars in significant hot or cold weather.
10. Make sure the power cord is not lying where a pet can chew on the cord.
