TRACK & FIELD STATE TOURNAMENT

Congratulations to our Track & Field Team State Qualifiers that competed on June 4 at Kent City High School. Thanks to Coach Jay Yockey for supplying the following information:

- Stepan Masserant finished the season with a PR of 12-3 in pole vault, and a 16th place finish. He went into the meet ranked last with a qualifying jump of 10-9.
- Noah Bauman threw 127-8 in discus for 17th place.
- Keegan Masters finished 16th with a time of 4:39 in the 1600, and 10:22 in the 3200 run for 23rd place.
- Jake lott ran a 52.29 in the 400 for 14th place.
- Annabelle Gapp, our only girl qualifier, finished 18th in the 300 hurdles with a time of 52.06.
- The 4x800 team of Keegan Masters, Ryan Oberle, Nick Oberle, and Ty Ruddy ran a time of 8:36 and finished 17th.
- The 4x400 team of Dylan Anderson, Ryan Oberle, Ty Ruddy, and Jake lott was ranked 19th, and finished 8th for a podium all-state finish, and school record breaking run with a time of 3:31.5.
