OCTOBER BOARD MEETING



TECHNOLOGY PURCHASE

At the Board of Education meeting on Monday (10/10), I will be asking the Board of Education to approve the purchase of 150 HG Chromebooks and 10 Smart Interactive Displays at a total cost of \$78,150. The purchase of 150 HG Chromebooks will allow us to decommission Chromebooks that are 5 years and older currently in our fleet that are no longer supported by Chrome updates. Students that are using these devices are regularly returning them for repair due to charging/battery failures and operating system issues. The 10 Smart Interactive Displays will replace older and outdated SmartBoard technology boards that have been in the district for several years. The purchase will be covered by our Tech Millage General Fund. For those of you not familiar with the Monroe County Technology Enhancement Millage, it was first passed by voters in 1997. It has been renewed 5 times since, and it provides roughly \$288 per student for students in Monroe County Public School Districts. Whiteford currently has a healthy Tech Millage Fund Balance of nearly \$180,000, so the purchase will bring that down to around \$100,000. Millage collected for the 2022-2023 school year will arrive in January 2023, which will help to replace technology devices as part of our 5-Year Technology Plan. DISTRICT STRATEGIC PLAN

The Strategic Plan 22-27 was Board approved at the May 9 meeting. It was created by a very broad and diverse group of 32 stakeholders and the survey results of over 400 people. Throughout the planning process, the community expressed high expectations for Whiteford Schools to become a world class school district and have all students graduate from high school. Even though some of the goals are extremely high, they reflect the strong desire that has been expressed to embrace significant change and dramatically improve the school system for the next five years. FREE & REDUCED APPLICATIONS

The nationwide waiver of the Seamless Summer Option that permitted all children to be served free/no cost meals ended. We still need your household to complete the Free and Reduced-Price Meal Application. The Free and Reduced-Price Meal Applications can be completed electronically using family-portal.cloud. Search for Whiteford School District, then click on "Apply for Benefits." If families would prefer to print a paper copy of the application for free and reduced meals, they can do so by clicking on this link. You may also pick up a copy in either school office. Please complete the paper application and return to either school office. If a student qualified for a free or reduced-price meal at the end of the last school year, they will automatically receive a free or reduced-price meal for the first 30 operating days of the school year. An application must be completed for each family wishing to receive free/reduced-price meals.

INFINITE CAMPUS

This summer, we have worked hard to develop ways to make the beginning-of-year completion of forms easier and less time consuming for our families. Many of the forms and agreements that were mailed in the past have now been "digitized" and can be accessed through our website or Infinite Campus. This process will be replacing Registration Day Packets for 6-12th grades and the Emergency Cards for K-12th grades. Please take a few moments to familiarize yourself with the information outlined in this letter. We hope that you will find it helpful as we start a new school year.
