We ask that parents/guardians continue to stress the importance of how/when to report concerning behavior by utilizing the OK2SAY student safety program, Monroe County Sheriff's Dispatch Center, and/or communicating directly to a Whiteford staff member or school administration. Together, we can be vigilant in identifying possible threats of violence!


