APRIL BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Education was held on Monday, April 17 . If you are interested in reading the full meeting minutes, you can access those here: Agenda & Minutes.

Here are a few highlights of that meeting:

- 1. Mrs. Michelle Delmotte, MS/HS English Teacher, was recognized as the March Staff Member of the Month. Leski Wittman Insurance sponsors the Staff Member of the Month by presenting the staff member with a gift card.
- 2. KG Round-Up was held on April 13-14. We had 51 students in attendance with 33 in-district, 2 children of employees, 10 School of Choice siblings, 5 potential School of Choice students. We are anticipating 3 sections of KG for the 23-24 school year.
- 3. The high school New York City and Washington DC Field Trip scheduled for March 10-15, 2024 was approved.
- 4. The purchase of the LockOut USA Security System was approved at a total cost of \$187,990.19 with partial funds from the general fund (\$94,106.19) and Section 97 Security Grant (\$93,844). You can learn more about this system: https://lockoutusa.com/


SUBSTITUTES NEEDED
