22-23 SCHOOL CALENDAR AMENDMENT

At Monday (5/8) night's Board of Education Meeting, the 2022-2023 School Calendar was amended to reflect the addition of an Early Release on Tuesday, May 23, 2023. On Tuesday (5/23), Whiteford is hosting the Tri-County Conference Track & Field Championships that involves seven teams. Competition buses will arrive between 2-2:15pm. Spectators will begin arriving about 2:15pm with the field events starting at 2:45pm. With our current dismissal times, we would have some major traffic and parking issues leading to safety concerns for our students and staff. Our goal is to free up much-needed parking spaces for spectators. MS/HS will be following an assembly schedule, and students will dismiss at 1:39pm. Elementary students will dismiss at 1:54pm. Bus transportation for our students will still be provided home.


SUBSTITUTES NEEDED
