# GREETING

After returning from Winter break, I hope that your child(ren) and you are settling back into a regular routine. We are asking families to continue to complete the <u>At Home Wellness Check</u> prior to sending your child to school each day. It is vital that you keep your child home if they are ill. If your child tests positive for COVID-19 or is considered a home close contract, please notify the appropriate attendance hotline: 734-856-1443 (Elementary Press 4, MS/HS Press 5). A school representative will contact you regarding isolation or quarantine guidance as well as how to obtain or access missed school assignments.

We will continue to monitor staffing numbers to ensure we can adequately maintain appropriate staffing levels in classrooms, buses, and other key departments. This will be a day-to-day analysis to ensure we are adequately staffed. At some point, we may have to pause in-person learning and transition to remote learning for a short period of time if staff and/or student illness becomes an issue. Unfortunately, these issues may occur quickly, so we are asking families to begin considering contingency plans for childcare. Again, WASD does not plan to move to remote learning unless we have no other option.

# STRATEGIC PLANNING

Our last Strategic Plan was developed in 2017, so it is time again to consider the future focus of the Whiteford Agricultural School District. School districts today are challenged to do more than ever before with scarce resources so planning for the future is more important than ever. We have partnered with the Michigan Association of School Boards (MASB) to help facilitate the development of our new Strategic Plan. MASB's Data-Based Strategic Planning Process will address three key questions for our district:

- 1. Where is the District now?
- 2. Where is the District going?
- 3. How will the District get there?

Data-Based Strategic Planning establishes priorities, focuses energy and resources, strengthens operations and ensures all stakeholders are working toward the achievement of common goals for the District.
