GREETING

Welcome to the 2022-2023 school year! It has been a busy summer at Whiteford Agricultural School District with the Bond Projects, on-boarding of new staff members and new learning for current staff members with new roles and responsibilities.

The Bond renovations and new construction is moving along in spite of supply chain issues. We have been very fortunate in that we had just one major delay in receiving our electric gear shift that supplies power to the new classroom additions: band, choir, art, and weight room. The gear shift was to be shipped back in March and arrive in April. Due to material and worker shortages, the gear shift was delayed for several months, but it finally arrived on sight two weeks ago. The new addition was to have opened the 1st day of school, but because of the delay with the gear shift, we are still a few months away from opening these new spaces. Once the new addition is completed, we will be scheduling an Open House to allow the community access.

Through the retirement or resignations of staff along with some new staffing positions, we have been busy on-boarding new staff or supporting current staff with new learning with an adjustment of roles and responsibilities. INFINITE CAMPUS

This summer, we have worked extremely hard to develop ways to make the beginning of year completion of forms easier and less time consuming for our families. Many of the forms and agreements that were mailed in the past have now been "digitized" and can be accessed through our website or Infinite Campus. This process will be replacing Registration Day Packets for 6-12th grades and the Emergency Cards for K-12th grades. COVID-19 GUIDANCE

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention updated operational guidance for K-12 schools on August 11, 2022. FOOD SERVICE

The Nutrition Group will provide the food service program. Meal service begins on Wednesday, September 7th and will include both breakfast and lunch. The school district participates in the USDA National School Lunch and Breakfast

Programs, which means that all meals meet or exceed the guidelines and regulations for the School Meals Initiative for Healthy Children. There also will be ala carte foods available during lunch.

We still need your household to complete the Free and Reduced-Price Meal Application. The easiest way to complete the application is by submitting your information on LUNCHAPP.COM, which can be accessed from the district's website on the Food Service page here. If unable to complete it online, please complete the paper application that can be obtained from any school office and return.

VOLUNTEER FORM

Whiteford Agricultural School District appreciates your willingness to serve as a volunteer in our district and become a substantial and vital part of our school programs! You can access the form here or from any school office. Please complete both sides of the form and return it to your student's building office, teacher, or coach. Background checks will be done on an annual basis. The background check process is time consuming; therefore, appropriate lead time must be given to ensure background checks are completed prior to volunteer service at the school or for any function conducted by the school.

GROWING TREE AFTER SCHOOL CHILD CARE PROGRAM

The Growing Tree After School Program is pleased to be able to offer a childcare program on a self-funded basis for Kindergarten through 5th grade. The after-school program is a ministry of the Whiteford Wesleyan Church. The program is licensed through the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Child Care division. The After School Program will operate during bad weather morning delays, daily after school hours, and early dismissals that are included in the Whiteford Schools yearly calendar until 6pm. Fees are \$6/hour for first child, \$5/hour for second child, and \$4/hour for third and additional children.
